Wilderness North accepts the following forms of payment: MasterCard, VISA or cheque. Cash is accepted for lodge purchases.

All trip payments are due 45 days prior to your arrival unless special arrangements have been made ahead of time.

Each lodge offers a point of sale program for incidentals like merchandise, beverages and guide service. Upon arrival, you will be required to fill out a registration card and supply a credit card in case you make any additional charges to your account during your trip.

OTHER THINGS TO CONSIDER

- Eight-Day Conservation Fishing License (required): \$34
- Daily Guide Services where available at Lodges: \$255
- Gratuities: typically 10-15% of final bill
- See lodge shop to purchase tackle
- Bedding **\$34**, PFDs **\$12**
- Rod & Reel Combos (one walleye rod, one pike rod) \$34
- Fly Fishing Rod/Reel: \$45
- Basic tackle box \$57, deluxe tackle box: \$113
- Beverage Costs: \$50/case of beer, \$20/case of pop or water
- Boat and equipment damage or loss insurance: **\$6**/day (per person)
- Makok River trips: \$198 (per person)
- Mim Brookie Fly outs to Keezhik (includes guide): \$765 (per person)
- Sightseeing tours at Mim: \$112 (per person)
