

An exploration of Canadian Canoe Culture. A fully-guided and equipped canoe trip into the boreal forest of Canada's North! Whitewater paddle through pristine waterways, explore ancient historic sites, camp under the northern lights and experience 2 nights at a full-service wilderness retreat.

DAY 1 WILDERNESS NORTH BASE

Enjoy glimpses of wildlife on your drive to Armstrong. It doesn't take long for the buildings to disappear and before you know it you are surrounded by the pure and natural boreal forest.

Arrive at your lakefront cabin where you will spend the night after getting acquainted with the beautiful change of scenery. Guides will help you pack and prepare for their canoeing adventure.

DAYS 2-7 CANDE AND CAMP

Embrace yourself in the immersion of nature. Our guides help you to tune in and enjoy your beautiful surroundings while you paddle. Rise with the sun, sip on warm coffee and enjoy a glassy Canadian lake. Let the day take hold, grab on to your paddle and make your way with us down the river. When evening falls listen to the crackling of the campfire while searching for the big dipper!

Our guides offer you all the skills needed to paddle down a remote river. Through flat and





whitewater you will experience a truly Canadian adventure. The canoe is a quiet way of traveling, providing the chance to see plenty of wildlife including moose, caribou and black bear!

Meals on the river are cooked over a fire, but embody the gourmet style that our lodges are known for. Food just tastes better over the fire, from fresh baked pizza to fish from the bottom of a rapid you just paddled, our guides have mastered the art of outdoor cuisine.

DAY 8 HISTORIC SITE

On your final day of paddling you will have a chance to explore historic sites before arriving at a wilderness lodge, Strikers Point. There you will be greeted for a welcome ceremony followed by complimentary happy hour and a delicious meal in the lakefront dining room.

Spend your evening by the bonfire under the stars and then head to bed in your private lakefront cabin. Pamper yourself and enjoy our fly-in access lodge hidden within the Canadian wilderness.

DAY 9 WILDERNESS LODGE

Wake up to a hot cup of coffee or tea delivered right to your cabin! Spend your day enjoying lodge amenities, using the recreational or motor boats, fishing, hiking, or relaxing. Enjoy meals in the dining room, complimentary happy hour, and the boreal forest at your door step.

DAY 10 FLOAT PLANE

Breakfast is served and it is your last morning to enjoy the beauty of the lake from ground level before an iconic De Havilland float plane whisks you back on your journey home! A stunning aerial view of the endless boreal forest is a great way to say 'bye for now'

Includes:

Flight from Strikers Point Lodge to Armstrong Station, ON; guiding and instruction, meals, snacks and drinks (wine and beer with dinner), equipment (high quality gear, including fully outfitted canoes), 1 night lodging in Armstrong, 2 nights lodging at Striker's Point Lodge, 1 day motor boat rental, Lodge amenities (kayak, canoe, etc).

Not Included:

International flights, gratuities, transportation to Armstrong, ON, fishing license, items of a personal nature, bait.
