Easy access to Ogoki River, Walleye, Northern Pike, & Lake Trout

Zig Zag Lake is a 7 mile long widening of the Jackfish River. This is one of our premier fisheries. The lake has very strong current flow and this allows for consistent action throughout the summer. The beauty of this lake is that due to its river like flow, it fishes very much like a large body of water. Big body of water means better chance for better numbers of trophy fish. Trophies of both species are caught and released here every season.
