

ADVENTURE FEES

Wilderness North accepts the following forms of payment: MasterCard, VISA or cheque.

All trip payments are due 45 days prior to your arrival unless special arrangements have been made ahead of time.

Each lodge offers a point of sale program for incidentals like merchandise, beverages and guide service.

OTHER THINGS TO CONSIDER

- Ontario Outdoor Cards(required): \$13
- Eight-Day Conservation Fishing License (required): \$34
- Daily Guide Services where available at Lodges: \$283
- Gratuities: typically 10-15% of final bill
- See lodge shop to purchase tackle
- Bedding **\$34**, PFDs **\$12**
- Beverage Costs: \$70/case of beer,
 \$20/case of pop or water
- Boat and equipment damage or loss insurance: \$12/day (per boat)

BAIT RECEIPTS

Anglers using or possessing baitfish or leeches for fishing in a BMZ (Bait Management Zone) where their primary residence is not located must obtain them from the holder of a commercial licence and be able to immediately produce a legible receipt upon request by a conservation officer. Baitfish or leeches, whether live or dead, can only be possessed or used within two weeks following the date on which they were obtained. The receipt must list the location and date it was obtained from the commercial licence holder, the business name, (if applicable), commercial licence number and quantity of baitfish or leeches obtained.
